As president of 84 Lumber, Maggie Hardy oversees day-to-day operations of the company and its 320 facilities which includes stores, component manufacturing plants, custom door shops and engineered wood product centers in 34 states.

After taking over the business in 1992, she refocused her concentration on the professional market. Her decision helped 84 Lumber top \$1 billion in sales for the first time in 1993 and \$8.75 billion in 2022.
